

CASE 3

On the event date 12-week-old female infant was brought to the emergency room for seizures. CT of the head revealed "old trauma" consisting of a subdural hemorrhage to the frontal area. Skeletal survey was negative. No external sign of injury. Retinal exam indicated diffuse intraretinal hemorrhage hemorrhages in both fundi, both eyes with no retinal detachment or retinal tears noted in the periphery. EEG was normal.

Coagulation studies were normal.

Result: Investigation halted.
